

Junket Rennet Tablets

Junket Rennet tablets have been around for a really long time. Junket Puddings and deserts were popular even before Jello became a household word.

I like Junket tablets because:

- They are readily available and inexpensive (\$1.50 for 8 foil sealed tablets).
- They are easily measured out (1 tablet will coagulate 5 gallons of inoculated milk)
- They are stable because they are in dry tablets.
- They can often be found in the pudding section of your supermarket.
- My family has used it for cheeses and deserts since WWI (so don't believe that crap you hear on the internet that it isn't any good!)

Rennet Equivalents		
Junket Rennet	Liquid Rennet	Gallons of Inoculated Milk
1 Tablet	20 drops or 1 teaspoon	5 gallons
1/2 Tablet	10 drops or 1/2 teaspoon	2 to 2 1/2 gallons
1/4 Tablet	5 drops or 1/4 teaspoon	1 to 1 1/4 gallon

USE OF JUNKET TABLETS: To use it, you completely dissolve the tablet 1/4 cup fresh clean water, then stirred it into the inoculated milk.
